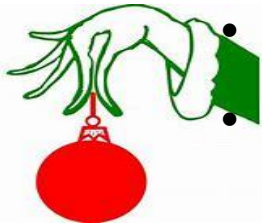


Ed Bray Art and Card Exhibit 10-4 located at gift shop entrance main floor

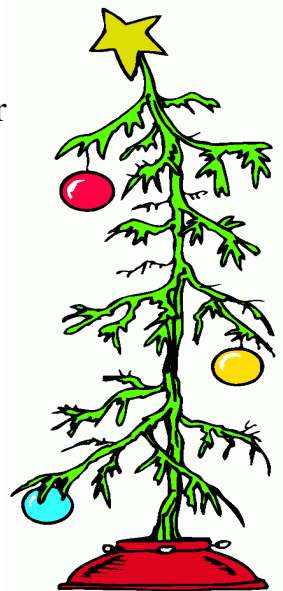
